

Auxilium Global Privacy Policy

September 2018

Introduction

Auxilium Global (“Auxilium”) understands and respects the Users’ need for privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how Auxilium collects, uses and shares information collected from its Users. We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time.

Applicability

This policy applies to information we collect when a visitor visits our Website (www.auxilium.global) and uses our Auxilium Platform. This Privacy Policy does not apply to the Auxilium (wallet) Software, which is open source, or the distributed open source global network accessed through that Software (collectively, “Auxilium Software”) However, if a user accesses Auxilium Software from a hyperlink on our Website, we may collect the information identified in connection with your use of the website.

Data collection from visiting our Website

Data provided by the User

The majority of content on our site is offered without the collection of any personal data. Auxilium does collect names, email addresses and all the other information that Users provide when contacting us. These activities in which Auxilium collects personal data, includes:

- signing up for an email newsletter or other online information service
- creating an online account
- requesting information
- contacting us using a web form
- leaving a comment on our forum

Cookies

When you visit the Auxilium website, we obtain certain information by automated means, such as cookies. A “cookie” is a text file that websites send to a visitor’s computer or other Internet-connected device to identify the visitor’s browser or to store information or settings in the browser. Auxilium uses these automated technologies to collect information about your equipment, browsing actions and usage patterns. The information we obtain in this manner may include your IP address, identifiers associated with your devices, types of devices connected to our services, web browser characteristics, device characteristics, language preferences, referring/exit pages, clickstream data, and dates and times of visits to our Website.

The information we collect through cookies and similar technologies helps us (1) remember your information for future use of the website; (2) understand how you use and interact with our website; (3) measure the usability of our website and the effectiveness of our communications; and (4) otherwise manage and enhance our website, and help ensure it is working properly. Your browser may tell you how to be notified when you receive certain types of cookies or how to restrict or disable certain types of cookies. Please note, however, that without cookies you may not be able to use all of the features of our website.

Google Analytics: Auxilium uses the 'Google Analytics' service provided by Google Inc. This service analyses the use of the Auxilium website by its visitors and collects statistical data about user behavior. The data Google collect is made anonymous. Google Analytics collects for example the number of visits per page, how long visitors stay on a page, the countries where these visitors come from and the pages clicked. We use this service in order to improve our Website and Platform. Google Analytics carries out this analysis using cookies. Auxilium has entered into a processor agreement with Google. Google does not use any of this data for its own purposes

Data collection from using our platform

When using the Social Media communication methods available on the Auxilium Platform, the information provided by the User gets stored in order to fulfill the communication to the Users.

Auxilium collects this data for purposes relating to the provision of the Platform, and include the administration, monitoring, and ongoing management of the Auxilium platform;

Data collection from using our Software

The Auxilium Software (Auxilium Wallet) enables Auxilium Coin holders (AUX-Coins) to connect to their digital asset exchange accounts in order to check balances, receive payment estimates, submit instructions for payments initiation, and check status of payments in progress. Auxilium collects this data in order to give you access to your wallet.

On which legal grounds does Auxilium collect your data?

Auxilium only collects data when there is a legal ground to do so. These legal grounds consist of:

- In the performance of a contract.
- In case there is a legitimate interest: for example, when the processing enables us to enhance, modify, personalise or otherwise improve our Website or Platform to the benefit of the users. Or, to enhance the security of our services and determine if our marketing is effective.
- Based upon your consent: for example, when you subscribe to our newsletters, download our Software, etc.

Personal data retention period

Auxilium keeps your personal data for no longer than is strictly necessary in order to fulfill the purposes referred to in this Privacy Policy, unless a longer retention period is required by applicable law.

Personal data protection

Auxilium takes all the necessary technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data. These security measures protect against, among other things, loss, disruption, damage and prevent the unauthorized or unlawful processing or publication of your data. If you have any questions about how your personal data is protected, or if there are indications of misuse, please contact us.

Transfer of data to other countries

We transfer your Personal Data to vendors who use it solely to provide support for the internal operations of our website (e.g., technical support and network delivery) or social features of our Platform. These entities will not use your personally identifiable information for any other purpose, and maintain the confidentiality, security, and integrity of the personal information they obtain from us. With these entities we have entered into a Processor Agreement.

We don't (at this moment) share data with parties outside the EER. If we ever do so we will make sure to take additional measures, such as entering into an additional agreement with such party to ensure an adequate level of data protection for you.

We may disclose your personal information in the good faith belief that we are required to do so by law or to comply with legal processes, respond to any claims or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Auxilium or the public.

Your rights as a data subject

You, as a data subject, have the following rights:

- The right to access your data. This means you can submit a request to access the personal data we have collected from you.
- The right to rectification of your data if they are incorrect.
- The right to having your data erased.

- The right to object to (future) processing of your data or to limit such processing, provided there are no legal and statutory grounds for precluding this.
- The right to withdraw certain permission you have given to process.
- The right to data portability/data transferability. This means you can receive the data you issued to Auxilium in a structured, standard and machine-readable form. You can then transfer this data to another responsible party.
- The right to file a complaint with the local data protection authorities.
